

USA Coursework – Year 4

We will be carrying out a home school project again this term for you to work on with your child at home. Please see ideas listed below that you may wish to carry out or please feel free to come up with your own ideas.

Following on from last term's project the children are expected to carry out **two pieces** of work and to prepare a two minute presentation of their work to the class.

1. Choose a key state in the USA, for example New York or Washington and research key information on that state.
 - Population
 - Weather
 - Climate
 - Capital
 - Landmarks
2. Create a model of a famous building or landmark from anywhere in the USA. For example, the Statue of Liberty.
3. Create a fact sheet about the same building or landmark to go with your model.
4. Create a 2 minute speech on an influential American and why they are an influence; this could be anyone you look up to that comes from the USA. (They could be from present or past times). Some good examples of people are, Barack Obama, Abraham Lincoln, or Amelia Earheart.

Try and draw a portrait of your influential American to go along with your profile.
5. Research what natural disasters occur in the USA.

And finally.

On Friday 30th March we are going to be having a USA day. The children are invited to dress up as anything related to the USA and bring in USA food. During the day we will be working on American inspired activities.
