St Lawrence School Curriculum Letter- Year 2 Autumn Term 2025/2026

Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to Year 2. Mrs Caviglione (our Teaching Assistant) and I are very much looking forward to a fun and busy year with your children! Please see below for a breakdown of the planned teaching in each of the subject areas this term.

PE davs

Our PE days this term will be Mondays (outside PE) and Wednesdays (inside PE).

This term we are planning a trip to Mont Orgueil Castle to link with our History topic this Term. This will be on Friday **17**th **October 9am-12pm**. Children will be back in time for lunch.

<u>Jersey Music Service project (Friday afternoons, Autumn Term)</u>

This term we are excited to have a specialist teacher from the Jersey Music Service running weekly lessons as part of a Year 2 project. We will be using a range of percussion instruments, exploring using some initial pitched instruments (for example Pbuzzes, Ukeleles, ocarinas and recorders), and there will be lots of singing. Children will do some rhythm work, composition and action songs with pitched accompaniment. Our first session will be Friday 19th September.

As the project completes, you will be welcomed into school on Friday 12th December to watch a performance from the children. Afterwards, you will have the chance to visit the classroom, take a look at your child's books with them and discuss their learning journey in Year 2 so far. We will also be around for any questions.

'Let's get cooking' with Caring Cooks

We are very fortunate as a school this year to be continuing our project with the local charity, Caring Cooks. The 'Let's Get Cooking' Programme is a cross curricular and progressive skills-based programme for primary schools in Jersey, which teaches children the fundamentals of nutrition and how to prepare simple meals from scratch - a key skill in living a healthy lifestyle. Year 2 will follow the below plan for 5 weeks (exact date to be confirmed), in small groups. This project fulfils the **Cooking and Nutrition** strand of our Design & Technology curriculum.

Homework - Spelling

Children will each have a spelling Folder containing the first list of High Frequency words. The words children are unable to spell must be practised at home. I will test these high frequency words half termly and update the sheets. This is the same format that the children have been used to in Year 1 (although the words used in Year 1 were called Common Exception Words – we will now be changing to High Frequency Words). In addition to this, children will have a weekly spelling sheet of 5 words containing that week's spelling rule. This will be given to them on a Friday. Children will be expected to complete the sheet at home and return the following Thursday to be marked and updated with the next sheet.

Curriculum teaching this term

Reading

The school follows the RWI scheme for Reading. You will be informed in a separate letter which colour group your child is in and what curriculum objectives are covered in the sessions.

Writing

We will use high quality texts or engaging film clips as a driver for extended writing opportunities in Year 2. The Texts/film clips used this Term are:

Narrative

We will be examining characters and settings, building up to writing our own stories.

The Year 2 curriculum for writing focuses on the following aspects:

- apostrophes to mark where letters are missing and mark singular possession



- why some materials are suitable for specific uses.
- understand the properties of materials that make them suitable or unsuitable for a particular purpose.
- understand that some materials are stronger than others.
- how the shapes of solid objects made from materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching

Working Scientifically

Children will be:

- using their observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.
- performing simple tests.
- gathering and recording data to help in answering questions.
- using their observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.

Living things and their habitats - This term we will be consolidating and building on the children's work on materials in Year 1. This term we will work to identify:

- the differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive.
- a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats.
- how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain.
- different sources of food.

Working Scientifically

Children will be:

- identifying and classifying.
- observing closely using simple equipment.
- using their observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.
- asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways.

History (Autumn 1)

This half term the children will be learning about 'Castles'. During this topic we will look at:

- what a castle is
- attacking and defending castles
- weapons and seige weapons
- who works in a castle
- medieval feasts
- coats of arms
- castles in Jersey

Your child may enjoy looking at non-fiction books about Castles at home.

Geography (Autumn 2) – Why is (our place) so special?

We will be learning to:

- describe where a place is and how to get there using an address, maps and geographical vocabulary.
- describe what your local area is like and name some jobs that people do there.
- describe and show with maps where you usually go in your local area.
- use maps and atlases to talk about the weather and climate in the UK and where you live.
- identify and locate some personal, local and national landmarks and give some reasons why they are important
- do simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.

PSHE (Personal, Social, Health & Economic Education) – Relationships – (friendships and families) Autumn

For the initial stages of the term, children will explore the **zones of regulation** (managing emotions), build a **Class Charter** using the 'Rights of the Child' and build **a class community** through circle times, games and activities.

Once settled, children learn will learn about:

- the importance of special people in their lives
- · understand what makes a good friend
- conflict resolution
- how to make friends and who can help with that
- how to recognise unhealthy relationships/bullying and understand how to ask for help

PΕ

Sports Bugs (Autumn 1 and 2, Monday afternoon)

We are excited to continue working with the Sports Bug team all term and will be introducing the children to team play, communication and basic techniques for a range of sports, such as football, tennis, hockey, cricket and basketball. The children will be developing eye to hand coordination for batting and develop increasing accuracy in hitting skills. They will be using running skills to score points and practice bowling for hit catch run games. Further, they will be mastering basic throwing skills in game situations and participate in simple team games in a variety of positions.

Gymnastics (Autumn 1)

In gymnastics this half term the children will be working on their agility, balance, and co-ordination (ABC). The children will develop and perform simple sequences, including a simple movement pattern of at least four elements. The children will learn to perform jumps with power and control, to link different elements in a simple movement pattern and perform basic gymnastic actions and they will learn to travel at different speeds with control, to develop and perform a sequence.

Dance (Autumn 2)

Children will develop and perform simple movement patterns, developing control and working to link more actions into simple movement phrases. Children will work as part of a group to perform a movement phrase.

Art - 'Explore and Draw'

This term the children will be introduced to the idea that artists can be collectors: they go out into the world, look at things in new ways, and bring things back to the classroom to inspire their art. The children will be finding natural materials from outside to inspire line drawings and their creative pieces. They will be using wax and watercolours for their final art pieces inspired by Autumn leaves.

Religious Education

This term we will be studying Christianity, exploring the questions 'What do Christians believe God is like?' and 'What is the 'Good News' Christians believe Jesus brings?'

Computing

Children will be learning to:

- log in and out of Purple Mash (computing)
- open and use 2Dos
- Save work in the work area.
- make digital art

Book Bags

Please ensure that your child has the correct small, Velcro book bag. The small ones fit in their trays, with other items they need too.

Equipment

The children do not need to bring pencil cases or pens from home as the stationary they need is provided in class. We have a tray for water bottles in the class so that the children can stay hydrated during the day. They can re-fill this at the sink, if required. The children have access to their water bottles all day. They will need a separate drink with their lunch.

Break and Lunch timings

The children have break time from 10.15-10.30am and Lunch from 12.00-12.30pm (lunch play is from 12.20-1.00pm). If you need to take the children for any appointments, please be mindful of these timings in case they need to have snack or their lunch if they will miss break or lunch. Please also remember to let us know about the appointment in advance, ensuring admin@stlawrence.sch.je are copied for register purposes, and we will have the children ready to go.

Change in circumstances

If there are any changes at home that may affect your child, e.g. a bereavement, house move, hospital appointments, family members being away from home, change to family life, please let us know.

Birthdays

If your child has a birthday, they are allowed to come to school in non-school uniform on the Friday of their birthday week. We celebrate the children's birthdays in class (there is a special birthday toy they get to have for the day and they receive a little gift) so please do not feel that you need to send in anything. Unfortunately, we are no longer able to give our cakes or sweets any longer owing to a number of severe allergies in school.

Facebook

We will try to regularly put photos on Facebook of any interesting learning your children have been doing. We are aware that some children do not have permission for photos on Facebook. If your child was not on Facebook in Reception and you would like to give permission, then please let us know and we can send a form home.

Assessments

All children are assessed for RWI phonics regularly, over the year. In Maths and Reading the children complete a standardised test twice a year. In Writing, the children write one piece of unaided writing, every half term which is then assessed against the Year 2 criteria.

Allergies

If your child has any allergies, please email our secretary to let school know. We have been given a list of allergies that are on the school system, but sometimes these change, so it would be great to ensure that everything is up to date.

IT in school

The children will soon have their own individual log ins for the school computers. They will practise using these regularly. The children will be reminded of the 'Responsible Use' Policy and I have attached a copy of this. It would be helpful if you could read through this with your child.

Star of the Week

Star of the week will be awarded on a Friday. Please celebrate this at home. It is a fantastic achievement! They will come home with a certificate for display at some point during the week. They will also be awarded 10 house points and are allowed to sit on a chair during carpet time for the week.

Online Safety

Please chat with your child about any games they play that access the internet. In school, we find the children often talk about playing games that are not recommended for children aged 6 - 7. Dear Parents/Carers,

Reading Books

Your child will be bringing home **three reading books** on a **Monday** each week to read during the week, in addition to a **fourth book** from their Read Write Inc class on a **Friday**, which they have been studying during that week. They then have the opportunity to swap them during Read Write Inc sessions the following Monday (or to retain them if they haven't yet finished reading them.)

We will ask the children each Monday morning if they have books to exchange. We try to encourage them to be independent in this process but a reminder to return their books each week would be appreciated.

Where possible, please aim to read at home with the children <u>four times per week for 15-20 minutes</u>. It would be helpful to discuss with them what they are reading, to help them make predictions about what might happen in the story, to discuss any interesting vocabulary and to help support them in identifying the sounds they have learnt in Read Write Inc sessions. There are often questions for discussion listed in the books to help with this.
