

Treasurer's AGM report: 2024/2025

During the school year 2023/24 PTA was able to successfully raise £609.60 and a huge thank you goes to all parents who have supported all our activities.

Our first event was our hugely popular Hot Dog Day which raised a total of £352.19. Following the introduction of hot lunches, this was sadly our last Hot Dog Day.

Soon afterwards we re-introduced the 100 club which saw parents paying a set amount for a lottery number. All numbers entered draws on a monthly basis. This has raised a total of £402.30.

Not long after it was Halloween, and we celebrated with a Halloween disco which raised a total of £119.82.

At this festive time of the year, and in line with tradition, the PTA traditionally host a Christmas party with Santa stopping by to say hello and surprise everyone. He even came prepared with a present or two! This cost a total of £262.52. At the same time, KS2 performed a wonderful Christmas show at which the PTA was selling hot drinks and food. This has raised £255.89.

The spring term saw the return of Easter related activities along with our Sunflower competition. All the spring term activities combined raised a total of £146.09.

The school year concluded with Wacky Wednesday and the KS1 and KS2 sports day at which the PTA was selling drinks. Both events combined raised a total of £279.84.

Whenever the sun and temperature allowed, the children enjoyed frozen Fridays through which the PTA raised £311.57.

Over the course of the previous school year, we had the coin challenge. Each classroom had been given a glass jar for small change that could be brought from home. We have received some late entries at the start of this year. In addition, our pre-loved uniform rails were out at various times throughout the school year. We have raised £184.04 through that.

We have made a decision to fund more smaller "projects" in order to give the children who are currently in school the benefit of the funds raised. This saw our Year 3's receiving their very own recorders and our Year 6's receiving their leavers hoodies. This cost a total of £998.68.

In addition to events aimed at raising funds for the PTA, we have also been raising money for the football team by auctioning off a signed Jersey Bulls top in prior year. During the school year, we funded various football related items which cost £138.19.

The school year 2024/25 was my last as treasurer and I look back on 4 exciting years as I hand the role over to Kilian Dorey.
