Dear Parents,

“Can we explore it?”

This term we are following the project “Can we explore it?”. We are looking at different areas that we can explore and we are going out on as many educational visits as possible. I will send out a questionnaire to ask where your family likes to explore in Jersey, so that the children can talk about places in Jersey with which they are familiar.

Outdoor learning

Our site manager Sean has built us a huge pergola so that we can shelter from the rain and sun, whilst continuing to write, draw, play games and continue any activities which we would otherwise only do indoors in poor weather.

In the wider school grounds we are planning to explore the school pond and the new trim trail equipment, and there are lots of Forest School activities planned for this term, which will take place both in the Nursery and the school grounds.

Indoor learning

Indoors we will continue to provide a language rich environment which encourages the children to talk to each other and to staff. The children will start to learn the Speed Sounds Set One which is used in the Read, Write Inc scheme in the school and they will continue to develop number skills and handwriting skills. If you would like to hear examples of the phonic alphabet with pure sounds being articulated, you can click on these two links. Correct pronunciation of sounds is important so that children can learn to blend sounds when reading.

Many exploring ideas will be incorporated into self-initiated play in the home corner, sand and water trays and the art area.
